This Onion Will Not Make You Cry

THE GLASS ONION HAS PUT WEST ASHLEY'S DINING SCENE ON THE NATIONAL MAP

When owner Chris Stewart first opened The Glass Onion, the idea was simply to create a quality neighborhood restaurant off the peninsula.

What he and a few friends, some of them devoted customers, would help solidify was the idea that truly fine dining can happen anywhere, even in a casual setting, with farm-fresh, locally-sourced produce and meats in the hands of seasoned professional chefs and cooks.

Stewart said the biggest reason for The Glass Onion's success has been "a great staff and the great repeat customers who have supported us."

The menu tips its hat to Southern traditional fare, but does so with flair all The

Glass Onion's own. Its signature "Thunder Sauce" adorns many of the offerings that seem simple and straightforward, until their flavors explode in the mouth.


Like the chicken liver mousse, whipped airy and light, served on simple crackers, the dish brings together rustic approaches to food with a metropolitan pulse as the creaminess of the livers give way to the salty, briny under notes, and the crunch of the cracker is offset by the sweetness of the in-house made jelly.

There's certainly a worldliness about The Glass Onion, probably because there are farms all over the globe. While many of the items that went into "Braised Heritage Farm Pork Belly with Mashed Potatoes and

Summer Succotash" may have come from area farms, the dish would beat home on a New York City menu, or a bistro's fare in Paris.

So, do your mouth a flavor ... er, favor, and get down to The Glass Onion.

Whether it's swimming across a body of water he probably shouldn't have, or climbing a mountain he'd never seen before, Ray tends to take a decidedly different and sometimes extreme path.

Except when

it comes to his rustic breads and other handmade treats.

While many a bakery would settle to cut open a bag of factory-roasted coffee beans before brewing a pot, or slicing open a slab of grocery meats before making a sandwich, Ray and his crew have already rolled up their sleeves.

Not only does Normandy Farm use the highest quality ingredients in their breads, cakes, rolls, and bagels, but they also roast their own deli meats and roast their own coffee beans.

Walk into the store on any given morning, and there will be Ray or one of his employees cranking up an enormous roaster and throwing in anything from traditional Ethiopian Yirgacheffe beans or special imported Tanzanian peaberry beans. The smoky, earthy, and never

bitter brews easily outstrip the noise.

Ray will soon embark on a different kind of "brew," as he is in the final throes of putting together a pizza and beer garden downtown, as well as putting the finishing touches of a portable stationary bike-racing company that will visit other restaurants.

So the next time you're craving a roast beef on Tuscan bread for lunch or a cup of coffee and a bagel for breakfast, head over to Normandy Farm for an added side of whizbang-whoopee-woga-woga-woga.

And a salted caramel brownie...yeesh, are they good.



There probably aren't many chef/ operators in West Ashley who sleep over at their restaurants three nights a week like Anthony DiBernardo does at Swig & Swine.

Then again, there are probably not a lot of owners like DiBernardo in West Ashley. Or Charleston. Or South Carolina ...

A native of a small Philly suburb, DiBernardo went from cooking meals for submariners in the Navy to cutting his

culinary teeth downtown at Blossom and then at The Kiawah Island Inn.

Tacking from fine dining to comfort food, DiBernardo worked for Sal Parco (Mustard Seed, Boulevard Diner, Sette) for seven years before running the kitchen at Rita's Seaside Grille on Folly

Beach before finding a partnership with the Kish family of Queen Street Hospitality Group (82 Queen, Lowcountry Bistro).

"Barbecue is my passion," says DiBernardo, whose wife wondered why the big switch. "If I'm having to sleep up here three nights a week on a cot in the back tending the pit, just to make pasta, then there's a problem."

Creating his signature barbecue has been a trailblazing effort, too, as DiBernardo has assiduously avoided copying any one

or any region's style.
"My sweet red sauce starts
out with caramelized onions,
oranges and rosemary as the

oranges and rosemary as the foundation" before the classic ingredients of molasses, brown sugar and red tomatoes are added, says DiBernardo

"I've built my sauces to complement the meat; I built the sweet red to complement the brisket and

the Alabama white, with its mayonnaise and lemon juice and horseradish, to complement the pork belly and turkey."

Thesmokepitruns24hoursaday, sevendays a week, thanks to overnights from DiBernardo and a helper. They start off the meats with hickory until there's enough smoke to carry



flavor, and then finish the process with white and red oak and pecan. Tuesday marked Swig & Swine's first month-versary. It's off to a smokin' start.



In the last month, Mueller has turned his focus from the front of the house to the back of house, renovating the kitchen and the menu to offer more authentic German cuisine, schnitzel, goulash, bratwurst, German potato salad, and croquetten (breaded and

fried mashed potato sticks).

which are customizable. The Mama Mueller's Fav is topped with Swiss, garlic butter, herbs, and spices; the Berliner is topped with sautéed onions, bacon, and pesto; and the Jäger is wiener schnitzel pounded flat, breaded, sautéed, and served on a hoagie roll with mushroom sauce. The French, an Italian, a Swiss, and American are straightforward. Mueller's German beef burgers are served at 3/4 pound sizes. The beef

Burrell and Flynn should be a well-known name, as the two have run a coffee shop-turned-catering spot along Savannah Highway – one of several businesses the duo run in the area in addition to an equally massive consignment

shop in Columbia. The two decided a few years ago to sell one of their Folly Beach businesses, because it was just getting too much to handle, said Flynn, who said it was time "to cutback our workdays from 15 hours to 10- to 12 hours a day."

Flynn said there were opportunities for Consign Charleston to take a space in North Charleston, where national big box stores have struggled, but the more upscale, eco-friendly vibe in West Ashley better suited their store.

The dynamic duo continue to give back to the community that has supported their successes via charity drives, like a recent one that netted nearly 800 pounds of food for the Charleston Animal Society..
